1. Is my foundation secure?

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. (1:2)

2. Is fruit showing?

And this is my prayer: that you may be filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God. (1:11)

3. Is Christ central?

For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. (1:21)

4. Are my relationships framed properly?

In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus. (2:5)

5. Is my light shining?

Do everything without grumbling or arguing, so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a warped and crooked generation. (2:14-15)

6. Is my trajectory clear?

I want to know Christ—yes, to know the power of his resurrection and participation in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, (3:10)

7. Is my citizenship understood?

But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ. (3:20)

8. Am I living in peace?

Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. (4:6)

9. Do I know the secret of contentment?

I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. I can do all this through him who gives me strength. (4:12-13)
