This morning we welcome Bruce Main, founder of Urban Promise, a ministry created in response to the problems of inter-generational poverty and the incarceration of youth in Camden, New Jersey. Its mission is to equip children and young adults with the skills necessary for academic achievement, life management, personal growth and success. Founded in 1988 by Bruce and his wife Pamela in the basement of an unused Baptist church, Urban Promise began with just one adult staff, 12 college-aged volunteers, and a small budget. Today, the organization has grown significantly working internationally in 8 different US cities, in Toronto, and in countries such as Malawi, Uganda, Honduras, Liberia and the Dominican Republic.
