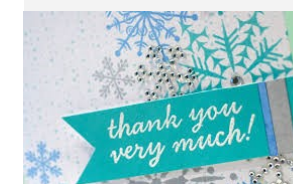
Holy Spirit, Holy Ghost, or Fuzzy Feelings?

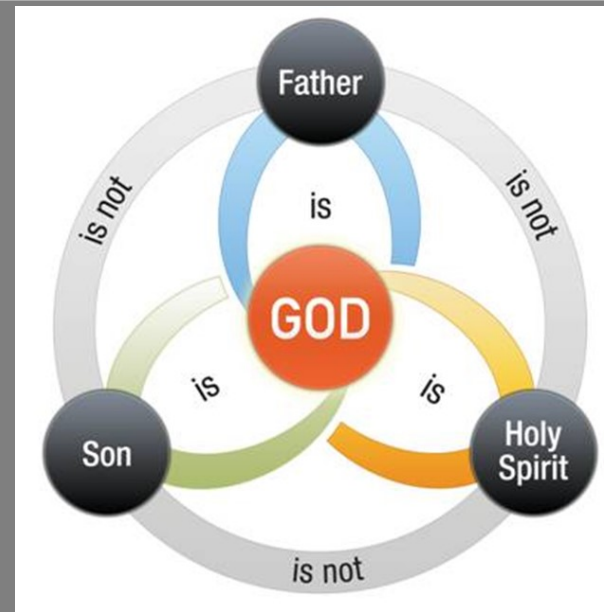
