Remember this story while you go HIKING! Do one (or more) of the following:

- 1. Go on a hike where you end up at a view point.
- 2. Go rock climbing and once at the top, imagine yorself high on a mountaintop with Jesus (if you are rock climbing outdoors this will not be a far stretch!)
- 3. Set out in your neighbourhood. Walk around local parks and maybe through the forest. Remember that Jesus meets you in quiet places.

Craft 1: Survival Necklace of Sustenance



<u>Craft Summary:</u> Make edible necklaces by stringing snacks with holes onto cord! This fun and simple activity is perfect for little hands and makes a sweet hiking snack when you're done.

Materials:

- Cord or string
- Cereal or candy with holes (e.g. Fruit Loops, alphabet pretzels, gummy Life Savers)
- Scissors
- Small bowls (for sorting the treats)
- Alternatively, you can add a needle onto the end of your string and poke whatever your heart desires

Steps:

- Cut a length of cord and tie a knot at one end.
- Fill small bowls with your snack options.
- Let kids thread the treats onto the cord however they like.
- Once full, tie the two ends together to make a bracelet or necklace.







Craft 2: Hiker's Colour Quest

<u>Craft Summary:</u> Make a portable nature color scavenger hunt using paint swatches and a clipboard! Take yourscavenger hunt as you go on your hike/walk/climb

Materials:

- Clipboard
- 6-8 paint swatches (from a hardware store)
- Clothespins or binder clips
- Optional: glue (if making permanent)

Steps:

- Gather several paint swatches in different colors.
- Clip them onto your clipboard using clothespins or binder clips.
- Head outside and find natural items that match the swatch colors.
- Pin each item on top of the color it matches.
